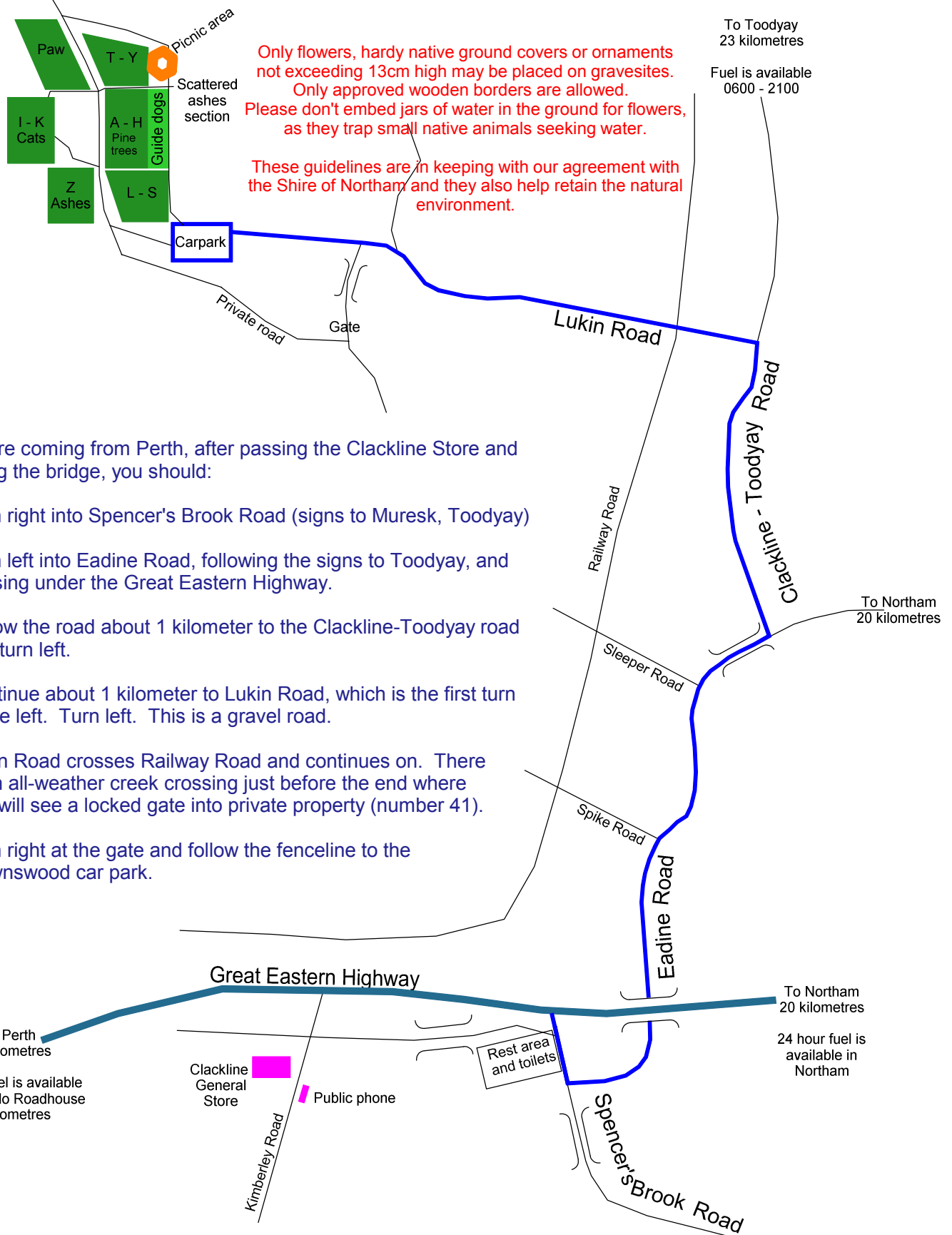


Visiting the Lawnswood Pet Cemetery in Clackline

To visit the cemetery from Perth you should travel through Midland via the Great Eastern Highway towards Northam. You will pass through the towns of Mundaring, Sawyers Valley, The Lakes, El Caballo and Bakers Hill before you reach Clackline. If you are visiting from the country, you may arrive through any of the towns Toodyay, Northam or York.



If you are coming from Perth, after passing the Clackline Store and crossing the bridge, you should:

1. Turn right into Spencer's Brook Road (signs to Muresk, Toodyay)
2. Turn left into Eadine Road, following the signs to Toodyay, and passing under the Great Eastern Highway.
3. Follow the road about 1 kilometer to the Clackline-Toodyay road and turn left.
4. Continue about 1 kilometer to Lukin Road, which is the first turn to the left. Turn left. This is a gravel road.
5. Lukin Road crosses Railway Road and continues on. There is an all-weather creek crossing just before the end where you will see a locked gate into private property (number 41).
6. Turn right at the gate and follow the fenceline to the Lawnswood car park.

NOTES:

1. Mobile phone coverage at Lawnswood is unreliable. There is a public telephone opposite the Clackline Store.
2. There are no water or toilet facilities at Lawnswood. Public facilities are available to the Clackline Rest Area.
